Further to gathering community input via a questionnaire and two focus groups, the Athol Public Library hosted an open house to get feedback on a draft of the library's 2023-2028 strategic plan. Displays were posted in the library on a Saturday afternoon, and besides being open to the public, the library also sent invitations and advertised the event, and also offered snacks to entice participation. Staff attended the poster prompts to interact with participants and answer questions.

In addition to their contributions via the data points named above, library staff were also asked to answer a short, three question survey. These responses are summarized in the following brief, and were useful in shaping the library's strategic plan further to the feedback that was gathered by other means.

These various methods of gathering input from multiple perspectives culminate in a strategic plan that is flexible, balanced, realistic, thoughtful, and proactive, and builds on the library's existing foundations while also reaching for new heights.
